

INSTRUCTIONS

Kite, Tiger 3-D

1. Fold a 12" x 18" sheet of construction paper in half. Place fold along midline of design and cut (Figure A). Figure B is the finished cut shape.





2. Fold along all dotted lines and decorate front as tiger, panther, wild cat or any fantasy cat (Figure B).
3. Tape center of Kite together as shown (Figure C).





4. Tape a plastic drinking straw to the back of the Kite leaving a "funnel" for air to pass through. The straw will form a bridge (Figure D).
5. Cut plastic strips for the kite tail (crepe paper will also work). The strips should be about 2" wide. Tie strips together to make a tail that is about 5-8 feet long. Tape the tail to the back of the Kite (Figure E).





6. Attach string through holes in front, knotting the string in a loose loop to prevent the Kite from tearing (Figure F) and you're ready.



- If your Kite flutters, try making the tail longer.
- If your Kite won't rise, try shortening the tail.
